**RE – ORGANIZATION OF GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT FOCAL POINT SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, Article II, Section 14 of the 1987 Constitution specifically provides that, “The State recognizes the role of women in nation-building and shall ensure the fundamental equality before the law of men and women”.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Executive Order No. 348, which approves and adopts the Philippine Development Plan for Women (PDPW), and the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 7192 (Women in Development and Nation-Building Act), all government agencies, national and sub-national levels, including local government units (LGUs) are directed to set up a GAD Focal Point System.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, EMMANUEL SALVADOR P. FRONDA II, Municipal Mayor of Balayan, Batangas**, by the virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby order the re-organization of Gender and Development Focal Point System (GFPS)

**SECTION 1. COMPOSITION.** The Gender and Development Focal Point shall be composed of the following:

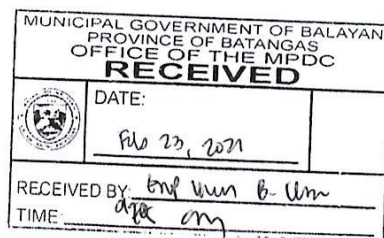
**SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS.** The Gender and Development Focal Point System shall perform the following functions:

1. To catalyze, coordinate, provide direction to, and serve as technical adviser for programs and projects related to women and gender development.
2. Sets direction, advocates, monitors, coordinates and provide technical advise on gender and development concerns.

**SECTION 3. FUNDING.** To be able to implement and the Gender and Development (GAD) activities, programs and projects, the municipal government shall set aside at least 5% of the total appropriation as provided for in Section 28 of the 1998 General Provisions of the General Appropriation Act. (RA 8522) and the Local Budget Memorandum No. 28 dated June 15, 1997.


