### ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2

#### **AN ORDER CREATING THE BARANGAY PEACE AND ORDER COMMITTEE (BPOC) EVALUATION TASK FORCE (ETF)**

**WHEREAS**, it is declared in Article II, Section 5 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, as one of the State's Principles, that the *maintenance of peace and order*; the protection of life, liberty, and property; and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;

**WHEREAS**, it is stated in Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 that local government units shall, within their territorial jurisdictions, promote health and safety, improve public morals, *maintain peace and order*, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 366 dated September 5, 1996, was issued requiring all barangays to organize their respective Barangay Peace and Order Committees (BPOC) to serve as the implementing arm of the City/Municipal Peace and Order Council at the barangay level;

**WHEREAS**, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2008-101 dated June 17, 2008 entitled Reorganization and Guidelines in Monitoring the Functionality of Barangay Peace and Order Committee (BPOC) was issued to ensure that BPOCs are organized and functional;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby create the **Barangay Peace and Order Committee Evaluation Task Force of the Municipality of Balayan**, to wit:

**Section 2:** Roles and Functions of the Evaluation Task Force:

1. Consolidate the barangay self-assessment forms (BPOC Form 1).
2. Review and evaluate the data entries in BPOC Form 1, all Means of Verification (MOVs), and relevant documents for the assessment of BPOC Functionality.
3. Give corresponding points for each indicator guided by the BPOC Functionality Assessment Technical Guidenotes.
4. Total all points for each indicator and indicate its Level of BPOC Functionality in accordance with item 5.4 of DILG MC 2020-047.
5. Conduct validation activities whenever necessary.
6. Create an ETF Secretariat, if deemed necessary, to assist the BPOC Evaluation Task Force in the performance of its administrative and technical functions.; and
7. Submit a copy of BPOC Form 1 to the MLGOO concerned.

This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.
