EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 1, SERIES OF 2021

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER EXPRESSING SUPPORT ON THE SUPPLEMENTAL IMMUNIZATION ACTIVITY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BALAYAN, BATANGAS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, DOH has been vigilant in preventing measles, rubella, and poliomyelitis- diseases that are highly contagious and may lead to grave complications including permanent disability and death which can be prevented through vaccination;

WHEREAS, DOH shall conduct its nationwide immunization campaign which shall control polio outbreak and stop the "predicted" measles outbreak in the year 2021, and Batangas Region is part of the Phase 1 of the Immunization Activity to be launched on February 1, 2021 to February 28, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Local Government of Balayan expresses its support on the Supplemental Immunization Activity of DOH;

NOW THEREFORE I, EMMANUEL SALVADOR P. FRONDA, II Municipal Mayor of Balayan Batangas, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Barangay Officials Participation and Assistance: All Barangay Officials of this Municipality are advised to assist the month long 'Measles Rubella (MR) and Bivalent Oral Polio Vaccine (bOPV) Synchronized Supplemental Immunization Activity from February 1, 2021 to February 28, 2021. This shall be conducted in respective Barangay Halls/ Barangay Health Stations.

All Punong Barangays and Barangay Officials are hereby advised to inform and encourage their fellow constituents of the activity.

Section 2: Activities: Our RHU Health Personnel shall conduct the following:

Measles Rubella Vaccination to 9-59 months old children

Bivalent Oral Polio Vaccination to 0-59 months old children

The schedule of Barangay Immunization Activity shall be released by Rural Health Unit for Information dissemination.

Section 3. All residents of the municipality with the children between 0-59 months old are highly encouraged to bring their children for the MR and bOPV Vaccination.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic Situation, the minimum health safety standard protocols shall be implemented during the Immunization Activity.

Section 4. Separability Clause: If for any reason, any part or provisions of this Executive Order shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts of provisions which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. Effectivity: This Executive Order shall take effect Immediately.
